United Health Foundation and Children's Minnesota: Improving Access to Care in the Twin Cities

Children's Minnesota is one of the largest freestanding pediatric health systems in the United States – with two hospitals, nine primary care clinics, seven rehabilitation centers and nine specialty care clinics.

According to *America's Health Rankings*, Minnesota ranks as one of the healthiest states for women and children. However, in the Twin Cities, children who live in underserved neighborhoods experience significant needs related to asthma, preventive care, and mental health. In 2022, the United Health Foundation, the philanthropic arm of UnitedHealth Group, and Children's Minnesota began a three-year, \$3 million grant partnership to improve pediatric health by bringing interventions directly to children and families in partnership with community-based organizations.
